

## **BCA 2014 Volume One**

## **COMMERCIAL ENERGY EFFICIENCY**

This course will provide participants with an understanding of the requirements of section J of the BCA for Class 5-9 buildings and how to demonstrate compliance with the Deemed-to-Satisfy Provisions.

This course is split up into 3 parts as follows:

- 1. Optional Solutions Explains the differences between Performance Based solutions and Deemed-to-Satisfy solutions and explores the methodology for application of Verification methods. Differences between Class 2 to 9 buildings will be detailed.
- 2. Elemental Provisions Examines the Deemed-to-Satisfy provisions for elemental provisions in detail, including Building Fabric, Glazing and Building Sealing. Minimum compliance levels are explored and optional types of construction systems compared.
- **3. Services** Explores BCA requirements for services, including air-conditioning and ventilation systems, artificial lighting and power, hot water systems, swimming pool and spa pool plant.
