

WHY ATTEND?

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to recognise and respond to life-threatening emergencies in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines. This unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide an emergency response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

This course will provide you with the skills and knowledge to recognise and respond to life threatening emergencies in a range of situations:

- D.R.S.A.B.C.D. action plan
- Principles of first aid and chain of survival
- Legal issues and infection control
- Basic anatomy and physiology considerations in provision of first aid
- Choking and airway obstruction
- Asthma and Chest pain
- CPR: 4 minutes of uninterrupted
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation on the floor
- Use of an Automated External Defibrillator
- Severe allergic and anaphylactic reactions
- Severe bleeding and shock
- Stress management awareness
