As required by the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Regulations the course provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to test and tag portable electrical equipment on demolition, construction and mine sites.

Required pre-requisite: It is required by the training provider - Frontline Safety & Training Services that you have obtained either, CPCCOHS1001A Work Safely in the Construction Industry (white card) or Safety Awareness (blue card) and to provide a copy of your card or Statement of Attainment together with your registration form
