Dogging CPCCLDG3001A

(The Registered Training Organisation, Industrial Foundation for Accident Prevention (IFAP) 1907 will be the RTO issuing Statement of Attainment for this unit of competency).

This aim of this 5 day course is to provide you with the knowledge and practical skills required to demonstrate competency in the application of slinging techniques, selection and inspection of lifting gear and/or the directing of the crane/operator in the movement of the load.

This course is designed for those who intend to work with cranes and also who may be required to dog loads with load shifting equipment.

This unit is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work and requires

Plan the job;

Perform task; and

Select and inspect equipment;

Shut down job and clean up.

Prepare site and equipment;

Pre-requisite: Participant must be at least 18 years of age and can use the English language at a level that enables the safe performance of high risk as specified in the competency standards.

Upon successful completion of the assessment requirements you will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for CPCCLDG3001A Licence to perform dogging and a Notice of Assessment (interim licence).
