(The Registered Training Organisation, Industrial Foundation for Accident Prevention (IFAP) 1907 will be the RTO issuing Statement of Attainment for this unit of competency).

This aim of this 2 day course is to provide you with the knowledge and practical skills required to be able to plan the work, conduct routine checks, set up elevating work platform, operate elevating work platform and shut down and secure elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more).

This unit is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work and requires the operator to be able to: -

- Plan work;
- Conduct routine checks:
- Set up elevating work platform;
- Operate elevating work platform;
- Shut down and secure elevating work platform.

Pre-requisite: Participant must be at least 18 years of age and can use the English language at a level that enables the safe performance of high risk as specified in the competency standards.

Upon successful completion of the assessment requirements you will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for TLILIC2005A Licence to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more) and a Notice of Assessment (interim licence).
