

WHY ATTEND?

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work.

This unit of competency specifies the outcomes required to undertake Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) induction training within the construction industry. It relates directly to the general induction training program specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work (ASCC 2007).

This course is well suited to the job roles including Construction Worker, Labourer, Security Officer (when working on a construction site), any other occupation on a construction site.

- Identifying health and safety legislative requirements of construction work
- Identifying construction hazards and risk control measures
- Identifying health and safety communication and reporting processes
- Identifying incident and emergency response procedures
