## **THE QUESTION**

We live in a large heritage cottage and have received initial advice that we can use three bedrooms for bed and breakfast accommodation. The council has said we may also need building approval, but we are not undertaking any building work, only painting and general tidying up. We already have smoke alarms installed also.

## **THE ANSWER**

A home with a new bed and breakfast accommodation use requires both building and planning approval from the council.

Initial discussions with council regarding the proposal have restricted you to a maximum of three bedrooms for this use.

This limits the impact on adjoining neighbours. However, this is only preliminary advice; you may need to consult with adjoining land owners as part of the formal application process.

For building, the use of part of your home to host guests requires an occupancy permit.

This is because under the Building Code of Australia, a house is a Class 1a, and a boarding house or short-term holiday accommodation of unrelated persons is a Class 1b building.

A Class 1b property cannot exceed 300sqm, so hopefully your home is not too big.

Although your home has smoke alarms installed, the minimum requirements for smoke alarms in residential buildings has recently changed.

Smoke alarms are now required to be interconnected, meaning all installed alarms will sound if one is activated.

Smoke alarms for a home need to be hard-wired and located on each storey of the building between living and sleeping areas.

For a Class 1b (bed and breakfast) building, the

requirements are slightly different.

Smoke alarms are required in each bedroom, in each corridor or area between the bedrooms and remainder of the building, on each storey and a system of lighting is required to assist the evacuation of occupants in the evening of a fire.

The lighting must be activated by the smoke alarms installed.

Because there are less than four rooms earmarked for use as bed and breakfast, you are not required to provide access for people with disabilities under the Access Standards.

However, it would be recommended you consider making your building access-friendly with smooth access ways, comfortable door widths and facilities.

In order to undertake this work, you will need a building permit and a certificate of building compliance to accompany the application for the occupancy permit.

You will need a registered building and surveying contractor.
