

## MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

The Master Builders Association of Western Australia (the Association) is an association of employers who work predominantly in the Building and Construction Industry (the industry).

Membership is open to the following persons or entities operating as builders, subcontractors, tradespeople, project managers, consultants, suppliers and other persons engaged in any capacity in the building and construction industry.

- Persons who are self-employed; or
- Firms, partnerships, associations, corporations, incorporated or unincorporated bodies, trustees, companies or a body duly registered under the Corporations Act, or combination thereof that employ other people in the industry.

Where an application is made by a person to join the Association on behalf of a legal entity as recognised above, that person shall be deemed for the purposes of membership to be an authorised representative. An authorised representative will ordinarily be the principal of a company, a sole trader, partner in a partnership, or a trustee in a trust.

In those membership categories where only practitioners registered pursuant to the Building Act are lawfully permitted to carry out building work, compliance with such registration requirements is also a threshold condition of eligibility for full membership.

The following criteria set out the requirements for membership of the Association.
